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Spending Bill Affects ACA Taxes & Fees

This week, President Trump signed into law a short-term continuing spending resolution to end the government shutdown and continue funding through Feb. 8, 2018. This short-term spending bill impacts three taxes and fees under the Affordable Care Act (ACA).

Specifically, the bill:

- Delays implementation of the **Cadillac tax** on high-cost group health coverage until 2022;
- Provides a one-year moratorium on the **health insurance providers fee** for 2019 (although the fee continues to apply for 2018); and
- Extends the moratorium on the **medical device excise tax** for an additional two years, through 2019.
